Preparing for use

The MARINER LED Lifebuoy-Light is ready for use in a few Steps:


STATUS OF DELIVERY

without Batteries

- 1. Unscrew the cap
- Remove LED light unit 2.
- 3. Dispose cardboard insert
- 4. Insert batteries
- (Note: To meet the SOLAS directive use MONO ALKALINE batteries only
- 5. Insert LED light unit Attention: Note contacts! (Fig.1)
- Tighten the cap firmly 6.

with Batteries

- 1. Unscrew the cap
- 2. Remove LED light unit
- Dispose cardboard disc 3.
- Insert LED light unit 4.
- 5. Attention: Note contacts!
- (Fig.1) 6.
 - Tighten the cap firmly



Attention

The MARINER LED Lifebuoy-Light has to be stored in upside down position (cap downwards, see Fig. 2). The activation is done automatically by floating in water through upright position (Fig. 3).

Function

The MARINER LED Lifebuoy-Light is specifically developed to be used in combination with a lifebuoy during twilight / darkness.


After the device is thrown overboard

into the water, it activates automatically.
